Spring Raffle is \$200/family (Mandatory) Due May 1st

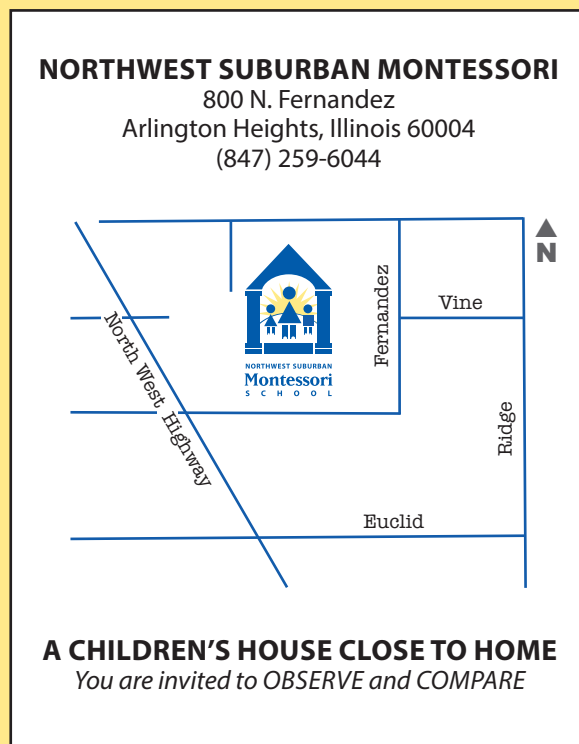
